# Academy Information Published on Websites

**Review frequency:** Live – updates must be uploaded as soon as possible after a change.

**Approval:** Governing body free to delegate to a committee of the governing body, an individual governor or the Headteacher.

## Policy Statement

### Introduction

The L.E.A.D. Academy Trust requires this policy to be implemented by all its member academies.

We believe in transparency in our dealings with all stake-holders and everyone having an interest in our work.

The L.E.A.D. Academy Trust will publish:

- Annual accounts for at least the previous two years
- A value for money statement
- An annual report
- The current memorandum of association
- The Trust's articles of association
- The Trust's funding agreement
- Charity trustees' and members' names

The L.E.A.D. Academy Trust defines the policy expectation, but the responsibility for implementation of the policy rests with the Headteacher of each academy.

### Legal Framework

Legislation applies only to maintained schools, but new Funding Agreements require academies to publish this information.

### Policy

Each academy must publish the following on its website:

- Academy contact details
- Admission arrangements
- Most recent Ofsted report
- Department for Education Performance data including a link to the DfE school performance tables website
- Curriculum Information on curriculum provision, content and approach.
  - For primary academies - this must include the names of any KS1 phonics or reading schemes
  - For secondary academies – this must include a list of the courses available to pupils at KS4 including GCSEs
  - For all academies – this must include how parents or other members of the public can find out more about the curriculum the school is following. - Behaviour Policy
- Pupil Premium: Details of pupil premium allocation, its use and impact for the previous academic year and the academic year currently running
- SEN/D information report
- Year 7 literacy and numeracy Catch Up Premium: Details of catch up premium allocation, its use and impact for the previous academic year and the academic year currently running
- Governor information and duties
- Charging and Remissions Policy
- The academy's statement of ethos and values
- PE and sports premium details
