### An overview of the theme Our local area and history.

This half-term, our Year 1 theme is Our local area and history. We will be learning all about our city of Nottingham and our local area of St Ann's. We will be comparing the toys we play with now and our school experience with that of our grandparents.

#### English

Your child will:

##### **Composition**

- Handwriting – (ascenders and descenders, letter formation).
- Phonics (phonetically plausible strategies, high frequency words)
- Capital letters and full stops

##### **Unit Work GVPS**

- Adjectives
- Sentence formation
- Conjunction and
- Orally rehearse sentences

##### **Spelling**

- Spell some high frequency words

##### **Reading**

- Apply phonic knowledge and skills as the route to decode words
- Read other words of more than one syllable that contain taught GPCs
- Develop pleasure in reading, motivation to read, vocabulary and understanding by becoming very familiar with key stories, fairy stories and traditional tales, retelling them and considering their particular characteristics
- Participate in discussion about what is read to them, taking turns and listening to what others say.

#### Mathematics

Your child will:

##### **Number - Place Value**

- Count to and across from 10 forwards and backwards beginning with 0 or 1 or from any given number
- Count, read and write numbers in numerals
- Given a number identify one more and one less
- Identify and represent numbers using objects and pictorial representations including the number line and use the language equal to, more than, less than, fewer, most and least.
- Read and write in numerals and words.

##### **Number - Addition and Subtraction**

- Read, write and interpret mathematical statements involving addition, subtraction, equals and signs.
- To represent and use number bonds and related subtraction facts within 10
- Add and subtract 1 digit numbers to 10 including zero.
- Solve 1 step problems that involve addition and subtraction using concrete objects and pictorial representations and missing number problems
