Classes: Foundation 2A and 2L

Foundation 2 theme is 'Animals'. Our special stories will be; *Oi Dog and Oi Frog, Pig in the Pond and Handa's Surprise.*

WELCOME BACK! We hope you are all well and as eager as we are to be back at school.

Our topic this half term is Animals. We will start the term by learning all about pets and animals you might find in a garden. We will then learn about farm animals and African wildlife. Across the term we will also look in more detail at how to care for animals, the lifecycle of a chicken and the difference between pets and wild animals. In our English inputs we will be introducing rhyme and rhyming words by exploring our key text 'Oi Dog!'. Finally, in mathematics we will be learning to estimate, using the language of more and fewer and learning our number bonds to 10.
