Theme: Scream Machine

This half-term, our Year 5 theme is Scream Machine.

English

Your child will:

In Year 5, our focus text is 'The Viewer'. Connected to this text, the children will be focusing on narrative writing where they will learn about:

- Figurative language, including the use of personification, hyperbole, similes and metaphors.
- Setting descriptions
- Diaries
- Relative pronouns and subordinating conjunctions
- Writing an alternative ending to a story

Mathematics

Your child will:

Number and Place Value

- Read, write, order and compare numbers to at least 1000000.
- Count forwards or backwards in steps of powers of 10 up to 1000000.
- Know negative numbers, count forwards and backwards with positive and negative whole numbers including through zero.
- Round any number up to 1000000 to the nearest 10, 100, 1000, 10000 and 100000.
- Solve number problems and practical problems.
- Read Roman numerals to 1000 (M).
- Add and subtract numbers mentally.
- Add and subtract whole numbers with more than 4 digits.
- Use rounding to check answers to calculations.
- Solve addition and subtraction multi-step problems.
