An overview of the theme: Me in My World.

**Welcome to Year 1, we are so happy to welcome you, your family and your child back to school!
This half term we will be learning all about our local world in and around St Ann's and Nottingham. We will also be exploring how life has changed from when our grandparents were at school!**

English

Your child will learn to:

Composition

- Develop their handwriting – (ascenders and descenders, letter formation).
- Develop phonological awareness (phonetically plausible strategies, high frequency words)
- Consistently use capital letters and full stops

Unit Work GVPS

- Identify and use adjectives
- Develop sentence formation
- Appropriately use the conjunction 'and'
- Orally rehearse sentences

Spelling

- Spell some high frequency words

Reading

- Apply phonic knowledge and skills as the route to decode words
- Read other words of more than one syllable that contain taught GPCs
- Develop pleasure in reading, motivation to read, vocabulary and understanding by becoming very familiar with key stories, fairy stories and traditional tales, retelling them and considering their particular characteristics
- Participate in discussion about what is read to them, taking turns and listening to what others say.

Mathematics

Your child will learn to:

Number - Place Value

- Count to and across from 10 forwards and backwards beginning with 0 or 1 or from any given number
- Count, read and write numbers in numerals
- Given a number identify one more and one less
- Identify and represent numbers using objects and pictorial representations including the number line and use the language equal to, more than, less than, fewer, most and least.
- Read and write in numerals and words.

Number - Addition and Subtraction

- Read, write and interpret mathematical statements involving addition, subtraction, equals and signs.
- To represent and use number bonds and related subtraction facts within 10
- Add and subtract 1 digit numbers to 10 including zero.
- Solve 1 step problems that involve addition and subtraction using concrete objects and pictorial representations and missing number problems
