


Learning for the Half-Term

3. What times are the nursery sessions?

We run a morning and an afternoon session. Our morning session begins at 8:45am and collection time is between 11:30-11:40am. Our afternoon session begins at 12:30 and collection time is between 2:50 – 3:00pm.

4. Do you accept 30 hour codes?

Yes we do accept 30 hour codes, providing we have the spaces available for both our morning and afternoon sessions. Please give the code to the office team and then speak to the class teacher.

5. Do you provide a lunch club?

We have a lunch club available for children who stay all day (who have a 30 hour code) and children who attend the afternoon session. You will need to provide your child with a packed lunch, unfortunately we cannot offer a school dinner for nursery children.

6. Can I pay for my child to attend extra hours at nursery?

Unfortunately we only offer half day sessions, unless a 30 hour code is given, and we can then offer all day.

7. Does my child need to attend every day?

It is important for children to feel settled at nursery and attending every day helps this to happen. If your child is unwell or there is another reason they cannot make the session please speak to the class teacher or contact the school office. Please note that if your child's attendance falls under 70% you may be asked to meet with your child's teacher and risk losing your child's place.

8. How do you communicate with parents?
