Class: 1G and 1M

This half-term, our Year 1 theme is Festivals and Celebrations. We will be learning to recall a celebration we have taken part in. We will explore different types of festivals and celebrations while discovering their purposes.

English

Your child will learn and practise:

Composition

- Handwriting (ascenders and descenders, letter formation)
- Phonics (phonetically plausible strategies, high frequency words)
- Capital letters and full stops.

Unit Work GVPS

- Adjectives
- Sentence formation
- Suffix -ed.
- Conjunction; and
- Orally rehearse sentences
- Re-read to check for mistakes
- Sequence sentences to form short narrative

Spelling

- Spell some high frequency words

Reading

- Respond speedily with the correct sound to graphemes (letters or groups of letters) for all 40+ phonemes, including, where applicable, alternative sounds for graphemes

- Practise reading books aloud that are consistent with their developing phonic knowledge and that do not require them to use other strategies to work out words

-Develop pleasure in reading, motivation to read, vocabulary and understanding by: listening to and discussing a wide range of poems, stories and non-fiction at a level beyond that of which they can read independently

-Understand both the books they can already read accurately and fluently and those they listen to by drawing on what they already know or on background information and vocabulary provided by the teacher

Mathematics

Your child will learn and practise:

Number - Addition and Subtraction

- Read, write and interpret mathematical statements involving addition, subtraction, equals and signs.
- To represent and use number bonds and related subtraction facts within 10
- Add and subtract 1 digit numbers to 10 including zero.
- Solve 1 step problems that involve addition and subtraction using concrete objects and pictorial representations and missing number problems

Shape

To recognise and name common 2d and 3d shapes

Place value to 20

- Count to and across from 20 forwards and backwards beginning with 0 or 1 or from any given number
- Count, read and write numbers in numerals
- Given a number identify one more and one less
- Identify and represent numbers using objects and pictorial representations including the number line and use the language equal to, more than, less than, fewer, most and least.
- Read and write in numerals and words.
- Count in 2, 5 and 10s
