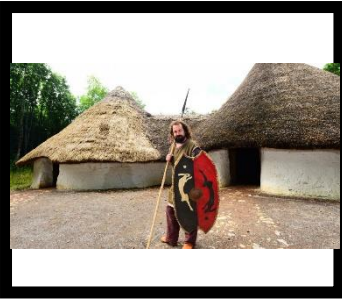

Theme: Tribal Tales

This half-term, our Year 3 big question is 'How would I have survived in prehistoric times?'

English

Your child will:

- Develop their ability to write a poem including using adjectives, verbs and adverbs poetically and writing similes
- Develop their ability to write their own adventure story including using past tense verbs correctly, using singular and plural forms of verbs and punctuating direct speech
- Develop their ability to write a non-chronological report including using commas after fronted adverbs, using subordinating conjunctions and forming paragraphs under subheadings
- Have daily spelling, guided reading and handwriting lessons.

Mathematics

Your child will:

- Develop their knowledge of addition and subtraction of 3 digit numbers
- Develop their knowledge of how to multiply up to 2 digit numbers
- Have daily fluency lessons where we will focus on the four operations in particular number bonds to 20 and the 3 and 5 times tables.
