<i>Boy</i> Your child will:	• Develop their ability to write their own adventure story including using past tense verbs correctly, using singular and plural forms of verbs and punctuating direct speech				
	• Develop their ability to write a non-chronological report including using commas after fronted adverbs, using subordinating conjunctions and forming paragraphs under subheadings				
	Have daily spelling, guided reading and handwriting lessons.				
<b>Mathematics</b>	Develop their knowledge of addition and subtraction of 3 digit numbers				
Your child will:	<ul> <li>Develop their knowledge of how to multiply up to 2 digit numbers</li> </ul>				
	<ul> <li>Have daily fluency lessons where we will focus on the four operations in particular number bonds to 20 and the 3 and 5 times tables.</li> </ul>
