Theme: Health and digestion

This half-term, our Year 4 theme is health and digestion.

English George's marvellous medicine Your child will:

- Develop their ability to write a character description, including the use of adjectives, prepositions, noun phrases and apostrophes for possession.
- Develop their ability to write their own story including the use of a wide range of punctuation.
- Develop their ability to write an eyewitness report, including the use of fronted adverbs and subordinating conjunctions.
- Develop their ability to write a newspaper report, including the use of direct quotation and the ability to summarise key events.
- Have daily spelling, PALS reading and handwriting lessons.

Mathematics Your child will:

- Learn about addition and subtraction of 2,3 and 4 digit numbers. This will include addition and subtraction with exchanges.
- Learn the correlation between millimetres, centimetres, metres and kilometres.
- Learn how to find the perimeter of shapes
- Multiply and divide by 10 and 100
- Multiply and divide by 3 and 6
