We will be learning about numbers 1-10, developing our counting skills, exploring number patterns and developing our knowledge of 2D shapes. We will continue to develop our phonic knowledge every day by reading and writing words and sentences with our new sounds. We will also be implementing a new phonics scheme 'Read, Write, Inc.'
