



<u>Theme—SAVE OUR PLANET!</u>

This half term our theme is SAVE OUR PLANET. The theme will cover topics such as how we can look after our planet and make the world a better place. We will be learning about important figures and reading books linked to dystopian futures. Please see the curriculum overview on the back of this page.

English



Our class text this half term is Boy in the Tower by Polly Ho-Yen.

We will also be looking closely at information on David Attenborough and Greta Thunberg's Speech.

During English lessons this half term, your child will:

- Write a biography about David Attenborough and his life
- Write an empowering and persuasive speech about climate change in the style of Greta Thunberg
- Write their own narrative with dystopian and futuristic themes

In Guided Reading we will be reading extracts from Boy in the tower and unpicking the themes and character using our VIPERS Skills. We will also be reading the text as a class at the end of the day.

Mathematics

In maths we will be focussing on Fractions, Decimals and Percentages. More specifically:

Adding, subtracting and dividing decimals
