
Year 6



Theme—Road Trip USA!

This half term our theme is Road Trip USA. During this topic we will be learning about the climate and economy of the USA and answering the question 'Would you rather live in the UK or the USA?'. English



Our class text this half term is The Graveyard Book by Neil Gaimon

We will also be looking at extracts from other famous books in the horror Genre such as Room 13 by Robert Swindells.

During English lessons this half term, your child will:

- Write a spooky setting description about their own graveyard
- Write a horror narrative based the short film 'Alma'
- Write their own diary entry with links to the short film 'Francis'

In Guided Reading we will be reading extracts from The Graveyard Book and unpicking the themes and characters using our VIPERS Skills. We will also be reading the text as a class at the end of the day. We will also be working closely on SATs skills throughout the half term.

Please be assured that although the theme is horror, all texts are age appropriate.

Mathematics

In maths we will be focussing on Ratio and Statistics. More specifically:
